PARKS PASSES NOW AVAILABLE AT THE STRATFORD PUBLIC LIBRARY

Stratford library cardholders can now enjoy free access to a day at one of three Upper Thames Conservation Areas. The park passes are valid for the 2019 season, and can be used for day trips to Wildwood, Fanshawe and Pittock Conservation Areas.

“We are grateful to the Upper Thames River Conservation Authority for reaching out and making these passes available to library patrons in Perth County,” says Robyn Godfrey, Outreach and Collections Librarian. “We hope these passes will be the first step in creating a “collection of experiences” for our patrons to enjoy.”

The passes can be borrowed on a first-come, first-serve basis and are good for one day for a single vehicle (or up to four people walking or biking). Anyone holding a valid library card from a Perth County Information Network library (Stratford, St. Marys, Perth East, North Perth or West Perth) are welcome to borrow the passes.
