Using Flipster in a web browser:

Reading magazines in a web browser requires an internet connection.

1. Visit: www.splibrary.ca/flipster
2. Click on the **Flipster** logo to visit the digital magazine collection.
3. Log-in with your library card number (if prompted for a PIN, use the last 4 digits of your phone number).
You may be prompted to create a new account with a username and password which you can use to log in with in the future.
4. Browse magazines by latest issue, category or search for a specific title.
5. Click on a magazine title to read it in your browser.
6. Use the menu at the right to flip pages, print sections, find the table of contents, back issues and more.
7. You can search within issues using the search box in the right hand menu.

FAQ

How many magazines can I borrow?

There is no limit to the number of magazines you can read.

How long can I keep magazines?

When reading in a web browser magazines are returned as soon as you close the browser.

Can I read back issues of a magazine?

Yes. Back issues are available for many titles. To access back issues, open the most recent issue of a magazine and choose the **All Issues** menu item in the right column.
