



## **KIT Card Information**

Our goal is to give a library card to all AMDSB students. We believe that access to library resources creates more opportunities for students to improve their literacy skills and build positive community connections.

- K.I.T. stands for *Knowledge, Information, and Technology*.
- Having a library card allows students to access the download library at school, and gives them access to all of the library's other resources.
- To access the download library, all you need is a library card and PIN. Your PIN is the last 4 digits of the phone number you provided at registration.
- Please note that when borrowing materials from the download library, there is an automatic return date. There are no fines for online resources.
- Fines will be forgiven for students' existing library cards on a one-time basis to launch the program. Note that this does not apply to lost items. If you have fines, please indicate this on the registration form along with the student's card number.
- If you had a library card and lost it, indicate this on your registration sheet, and you will be given a new card at no cost. There is a replacement cost for cards going forward.
- If your card is ever lost or stolen, report this to the library as soon as possible to prevent others from using your card.
- Huron and Perth libraries have reciprocal borrowing agreements. Once you have a card with one library, you can also get a card with the other.
- Individuals with print disabilities have access to the Centre for Equitable Library Access (CELA) and a wide range of physical and digital materials. Ask us how!
